Four Corners Back Country Horsemen announce annual consignment sale

Once again, the Four Corners Back Country Horsemen will be helping horsemen and women to clean up their tack rooms and barns by hosting the 14th annual Tack & Equipment Consignment Sale. The 4CBCH sale has become the shopping place of choice for budget-minded horse folks to buy and sell saddles, leather goods, camping equipment, cowgirl clothing—in short, anything related to the enjoyment of horses, regardless of whether the preferred activity is western, English, performance, professional or strictly recreational.

This year the event will take place on April 10 from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. in the Exhibit Hall at the La Plata County Fairgrounds in Durango. Goods can be consigned at the Fairgrounds on Friday, April 9, between 1-7 p.m. or Saturday morning between 7-9:00. Commercial and non-profit booth spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Consignment fees are 10% on trailers and vehicles (capped at \$500) and 15% on all other items (no cap). Minimum item price is \$5.00; consignors may bundle items to reach minimum. Consignor payment and unsold item pick-up will be between 4-5:00 p.m.
