

4CBCH Social Ride Rules

RULE 1: THE TRAIL BOSS IS ALWAYS RIGHT

RULE 2: IF THE TRAIL BOSS IS WRONG REFER TO RULE 1.

- No rider shall pass the Trail Boss.
- Riders will ask to pass other horses.
- Riders shall maintain a safe distance between horses.
- There will be no Running or Cantering on any 4CBCH ride.
- Do not leave the ride.
- No riding double.
- Do not bunch up at water crossings or drinking spots.
- At gates or other obstacles, move clear of obstacle, then wait until everyone is remounted and ready to proceed before riding off.
- All horses will be restrained [tied or held] during lunch stops or breaks.
- No smoking while on the trail.
- Guests must sign a liability release. Minors must have a parent or guardian sign the release in the presence of the leader.
- No loose horses in camp or on the trail. Riders must have a lead rope.
- Leave gates as you find them; obey all closures and regulatory signs.
- Pack it in; pack it out. Leave No Trace.
- NO DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED ON RIDES
- NO STALLIONS WILL BE PERMITTED ON RIDES
